


How to find the IFIP, TU Wien

Address:

- Centre of Public Finance and Infrastructure Policy
Augasse 2-6
1090 Vienna
Block D, 2nd Floor
Metro station line U4 or U6 “Spittelau” or tramway station line D “Liechtenwerder Platz”

Public transport from the airport:

- Take a train from the airport to station Wien Mitte/Landstraße. You can either take the regular regional train (number S7), or the express train (CAT). The express train is slightly more expensive and a few minutes faster. For both options you need to buy a ticket at the ticket machine before entering the train. The ticket machines are located in the train station of the airport. If you go with the CAT train, make sure you buy a ticket at the green machine that says CAT.
- From Wien Mitte/Landstraße take the green metro line (U4) in the direction “Heiligenstadt” to station Spittelau. Exit the station at J. Holoabek Platz. From there it is a 5 minute walk to the university campus at Augasse 2-6.
- See the map below for how to get from the metro exit to the university campus.
- See the instructions further down for how to find the building and the meeting room.
- Overall it will take around 45 to 50 minutes from Airport to meeting place.



Cab from the airport:


- This will cost you around 40€. You get the best option if you go to a cab company counter in the arrival hall of the airport. The cab will take 45-50 minutes.

Finding the building and the meeting room:

- At Augasse 2-6 there is a bakery shop (“Anker”).
- On the right side of the bakery there are stairs going up (see left picture below).
- Follow the stairs to enter the university campus.
- Once you have gone up the stairs the building is the big one straight in front of you (see right picture below).



- Enter the building.
- The building is structured into four blocks (A, B, C, D).
- Go half left to block D (see left picture below).
- Go through the door that says “D” (see right picture below). There are elevators on your left.



- Take an elevator to the second floor.
- Exit the elevator to the right and go straight. You might hit a glass wall. You have found the Centre of Public Finance and Infrastructure Policy. Ring the bell on your right and enter.
